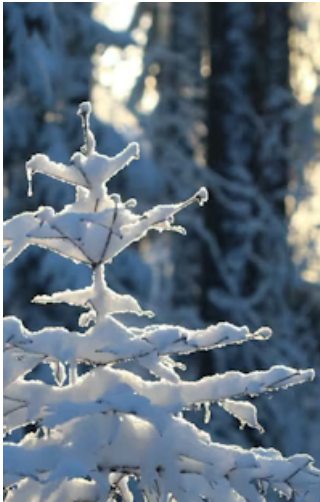

Using phrases like **"I wonder what would happen if..."** or **"I'm curious to hear..."** are simple ways music teachers can shift students' participation from passive followers to active explorers. Curiosity invites **experimentation** and encourages **imaginative listening** as students develop awareness of their own decision

making processes. When music teachers cultivate our students' curiosity, we highlight how much we value how students think, what they have to say, and the inner workings of their own musical persona. It's **an amazing teaching tool!!**

3. What new ideas, resources, or collaborations would you like to **explore in 2026?**

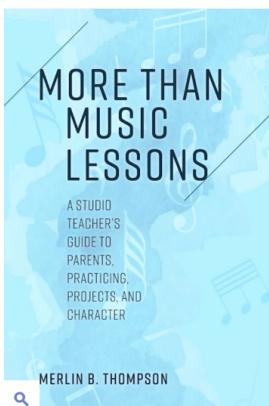
