

Must-Have Phrases

Have you ever found yourself in the situation where your student asks a question that catches you **off-guard or unprepared to answer**? What do you say? Here are three must-have phrases for those moments when students show up with unexpected questions:

- 1. That's a **great question** (Confirmation that you recognize the validity of students' inquiry).
- 2. Give me a week to **think about it** and I'll see what I can come up with (Good questions may take some time to find meaningful answers).
- 3. Let's **brainstorm** and see what we can create between the two of us (Students may already have ideas so let's include them in the process).
